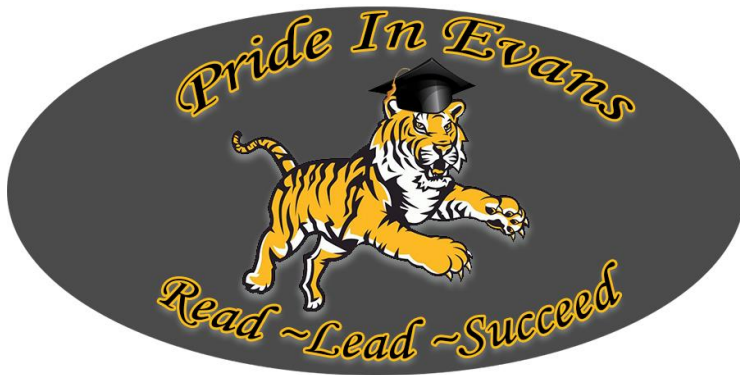

The C.A.F.E. focus is on three main areas: Positive Public Relations, Academic Success and Personal and Professional Skills Development.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS

There is no question that student achievement is linked to family and community engagement. Studies find that academic achievement has less to do with the quality of a student's school and much more to do with the social composition of the school and surrounding neighborhood together with the student's family background (Gamoran & Long, 2006)
